Re:	Overdue Regulations

Overview

By law, state agencies subject to the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) are required to report the status of regulations that are required by statute ("mandatory regulations") to the Legislative Audit Office by July 1 each year.¹ Additionally, for regulations not developed within three years of the bills' effective dates, the law requires the relevant legislative standing committee to hold a public hearing on the regulations.

In 2017, the Audit Office received reports from 64 of the 66 agencies subject to the APA.² Twenty of the 64 agencies reported mandatory regulations, six of which reported mandatory regulations relating to bills that went into effect more than three years ago. As shown in the table below, five of the six agencies have not promulgated rules required by seven bills. The sixth agency, DHHS, has substantially more overdue regulations than any other agency.

The Legislature, Commission on Industrial Relations, Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, and the Adjutant General's Office are not considered agencies under the Act. The Secretary of State is considered an agency, except when carrying out the requirements of the APA. The Parole Board may be considered an agency, but it is specifically exempt from the APA under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 83-199.

Background

Prior to 2011, Nebraska law did not dictate how long an agency could take to adopt and promulgate rules or regulations that were required by legislation. As a result, agencies were not held to any standard of timeliness. A 2011 memo by the Performance Audit Committee identified several regulations required by legislative bills that had not been promulgated several years after the bills had passed.³

In 2011, the Legislature passed LB 617, a Performance Audit Committee priority bill, requiring agencies to follow a timeline for promulgation. Agencies must hold the public hearing for mandatory regulations within 12 months of the effective date of the bill that requires the regulations. After the public hearing, the agency has another year within which they must adopt the regulations. This second year does not include the period during which the agency submits the regulations for approval by the Attorney General or the Governor. The bill also included reporting requirements, including that agencies provide an annual status update on regulations to the Legislative Audit Office. The status update must include information on appropriations related to the regulations. This requirement was enacted to address some legislators' concerns that agencies who failed to timely promulgate regulations might be repurposing appropriations.

In 2013, in response to concern that LB 617 was not able to address the backlog of overdue regulations from before it went into effect, the Legislature passed LB 242. LB 242 required the legislative standing committee with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the regulation to hold a public hearing if a regulation had not been enacted three years after the legislation's effective date. As a result, the Audit Office began asking agencies to report the status of all unpromulgated mandatory regulations regardless of the year legislation went into effect. This report is due to the Office by July 1 each year.
